The American Standard facility manufactures bathtubs and shower stalls. The facility consists of two buildings: the plant where all manufacturing operations take place and the raw material storage. There are seven (7) main processes occurring at the facility: forming, spraying, trimming, glueing, tooling, inspection / packing, and reworking.

- Styrene is a component of the resin used to make the bathtubs and shower stalls. Acetone is used mainly as a cleaning agent in the spraying process.
